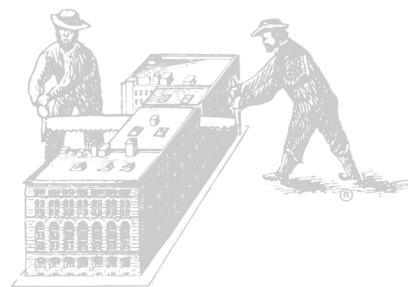

Heavy timber and lumber from dismantled warehouses, factories, etc. across North America. All original trees were old-growth, harvested from the Pacific Northwest in the early 20th century. Grown, sawn, built, deconstructed & remilled in America.

### >COLOR TONES

Rose, blush, pink and honey tones for soft radiance under foot

### >GRAIN PATTERN

Vertical, tight grain

### >CHARACTER

Infrequent small knots and minimal light surface-checking; few nail holes or stains, allowing other signs of previous life

### >DIMENSIONS

Custom milled to your order, from widths 4" and under; random lengths from 4' - 14'; in tongue & groove, square-edged with relieved back. Standard thickness is 13/16"; others available on request.

### >PRICING

Approximately 3 weeks; more is always appreciated

### >INSTALLATION

For all flooring, we suggest you order a minimum 5% extra allowance and schedule delivery to the site at least two weeks prior to laying the floor. Flooring should be laid as per install guidelines of the National Wood Flooring Manufacturers Association (NOFMA).
